



This sandbar connects Chicken island to the two smaller islands of Koh Mor and Tup in effect making the three islands become one. This picturesque and unique occurrence is commonly referred to as Talay Waek.
- <u>Poda Island (Koh Poda)</u> the wonderful beach on Poda Island is fascinating with white fine sand and crystal clear sea. It is undoubtedly one of the most favourite beaches for tourists.
